

Set location-based reminders through apps like Waze to alert you when you arrive at your destination. Never leave a child in the car unattended - even for 60 seconds.

Cultivate the habit of "Look before you lock", every time, even when a child is not in the car.

Open the back door every time you park to ensure no one is left behind



Always keep children in the seat directly behind the driver, rather than all the way in the back, to make visual checks easier.

Place an item like a purse, shoe, or wallet in the back seat to remind you to check before leaving the vehicle. Lock your car even in your driveway to prevent unsupervised access by children. Ask neighbors and visitors to do the same.

PARK WITH PRESENCE

Avoid distractions like checking your phone until you've ensured everyone has exited the vehicle safely.

Forget aesthetics! Install proper barriers, such as fences and selfclosing gates, around pools. Never leave children unattended around water, even for a moment.

Automatic pool covers to create a physical barrier over the water.

Ensure everyone in the family learns basic swimming skills, including floating and treading water. Emergency sign near pools that displays the address and phone number to call for help. It saves critical time when response is needed in seconds.

Provide water safety education and CPR training for both children and adults. Always designate a water watcher - an adult responsible for keeping eyes on the water at all times.

Keep toys, floats, and other attractive items away from the pool when not in use to prevent children from being tempted to reach for them and accidentally falling in.
